**WHEN:** Sunday, August 1, 2010, rides start at 7:00 am and 8:00 am

**WHERE:** Start/finish at Eucalyptus Picnic Area (small shift from '09), Coyote Point, San Mateo, California

**WHY:** Enjoy a day of cycling and outdoor fun with family and friends. Proceeds benefit San Mateo County Parks and Bicycle Sunday - car free biking on Canada Road.

The 2010 Tour de Peninsula is more than just a bike ride. It is a day of fun, fitness, and healthy activities for all the family. Everybody is invited to take part in one of Northern California’s most fun recreational cycling events/family/social gatherings – the Tour de Peninsula – held in scenic Coyote Point Park fronting the San Francisco Bay in San Mateo. Founded 19 years ago, the TdP is a perennial highlight of the Bay Area's recreational social calendar, offering a variety of routes to suit everyone from young children and first time riders to serious cyclists. During and after the ride, a day of family fun activities takes place in the park, with [a children’s playground](#), barbecuing, picnics, live music, and equally lively conversation. Proceeds benefit San Mateo County Parks and Bicycle Sunday - car free biking on Canada Road.

### Route Options

**Kids/Family Route** – 1-3 miles on bike trail in Coyote Point Park begins at 12 noon

**Short Route** for beginner to intermediate cyclists – 20 miles begins at 8 am

**Long Route** for intermediate to experienced cyclists – 31 miles begins at 8 am

**Metric Century** for advanced cyclists – 63 miles (contains short-cut for 50-mile option) begins at 7 am

### Registration

Through June 30: Kids 11 and under are free. 12-16 year olds: \$20. Adults 17 and over: \$40.

July 1-- July 29: Kids 11 and under are free. 12-16 year olds: \$25. Adults 17 and over: \$45.

Registration for 12 and older includes T-shirt.
