

# Inspiring people to care for, learn about and enjoy our parks. Highlights 1999 - 2013

#### August 1999

Foundation makes first gift to San Mateo County Parks: \$68,000.

#### February 2000

Foundation donates \$125,000 to help replace playground equipment at Flood County Park.

# April 2001

Foundation makes gift of \$188,000 to County Parks.

## April 2001

Foundation funds the Community Planning Phase of the interpretive center proposed for Edgewood County Park and Natural Preserve – the beginning of a 10-year project.

## July 2001

The Foundation publishes San Mateo County Parks: A Remarkable Story of Extraordinary Places and the People who Built Them.



#### October 2002

Just three years after the Foundation was started, gifts top the one million dollar mark.

#### November 2002

Foundation begins raising funds for the design phase of the interpretive center at Edgewood.



# March 2003

A foundation-secured grant of \$1.6 million funds acquisition and planing for Mirada Surf.

#### June 2003

Foundation presents a check for \$198,500 to County Parks.

#### April 2005

Executive Director Julia Bott receives the Jefferson Award for Public Service, recognizing her committment to our parks.

#### June 2005

More than \$575,000 in grants secured by the Foundation were paid directly to County parks.

#### August 2005

Tour de Peninsula riders raise \$19,887 for Bicycle Sunday and increase awareness of Parks.

#### June 2006

Foundation secures \$811,000 in donations and grants for County Parks.

#### June 2006

Foundation provides matching grant for the planning phase of extending Crystal Springs Trail south of Highway 92.

#### August 2009

Tour de Peninsula start & finish moves to Coyote Point – strengthing the connection to County Parks.

#### March 2010

Foundation donates \$785,000 toward the Bill and Jean Lane Education Center in Edgewood.

#### June 2010

Foundation contributions for the year total \$389,069.

# April 2011

The Bill and Jean Lane Education Center opens at Edgewood, the culmination of a decade of planning, fundraising, and project management.



# June 2011

Foundation donates \$730,465 in cash and in-kind support for Parks.

#### June 2012

Foundation contributes \$380,371 to County Parks.

#### May 2013

Foundation donates \$388,000 to improve the western shoreline promenade at Coyote Point.

#### June 2013

Foundation contributes \$117,919 in cash and in-kind gifts to County Parks.
